



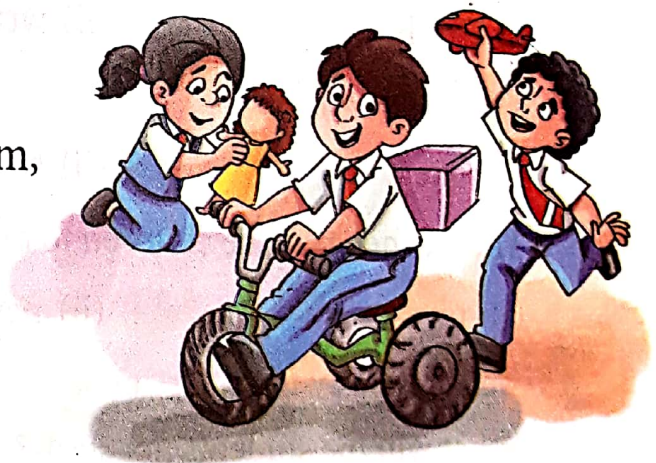
Welcome Back to School! (Poem)
