The place, people, things and nature that surround any living organism is called environment.

The natural environment that includes all things both living and non-living that occur naturally on earth and human environment includes constructed surroundings or built up areas like buildings, roads, machines and social and cultural factors like family and school.

The three realm of the earth - lithosphere, hydrosphere and atmosphere support life.

Ecosystem is a system formed by the interaction of all living organisms with each other and with their environment through transfer of energy and material. An ecosystem can be natural and artificial. Rain forest, desert, ponds, rivers etc are the example of natural ecosystem.
