Lesson-2 'The sentence'

Every sentence has two parts: Subject and predicate

Subject → The person or thing we speak about is the subject.

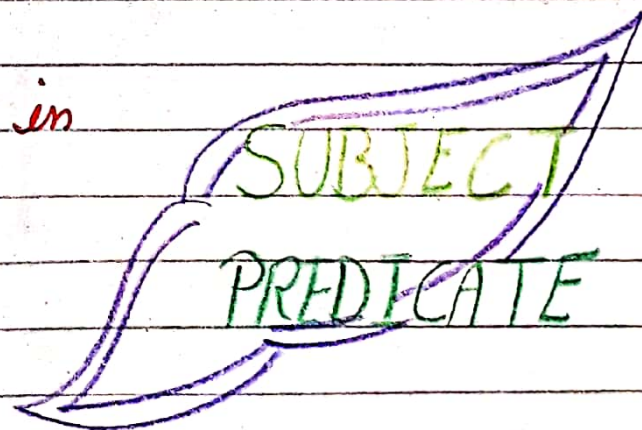
Predicate → What is said about the subject is the predicate.

Example → 1- Rajat is sitting on a chair.

2- The boy is sleeping on the bed.

In the above-mentioned sentences, the words in colour are persons, we speak about. This part of given sentence is called subject. The verb and the remaining word of each sentence that are red underline form the predicate.
