## Lesson-2 Plant life

There are different kinds of plants all around us. Plants have different parts. Plant's body is divided into two main parts: Shoot and Root

1- Shoot → The part of the plant which grows above the ground is called the shoot. The shoot has stem, leaves, branches, buds, flowers and fruits.

2- Root → The part of the plant which grows below the ground is called the root. There are two types of roots: Tap root and fibrous root.

Tap root → Ex. → Neem, bean, balsam etc.

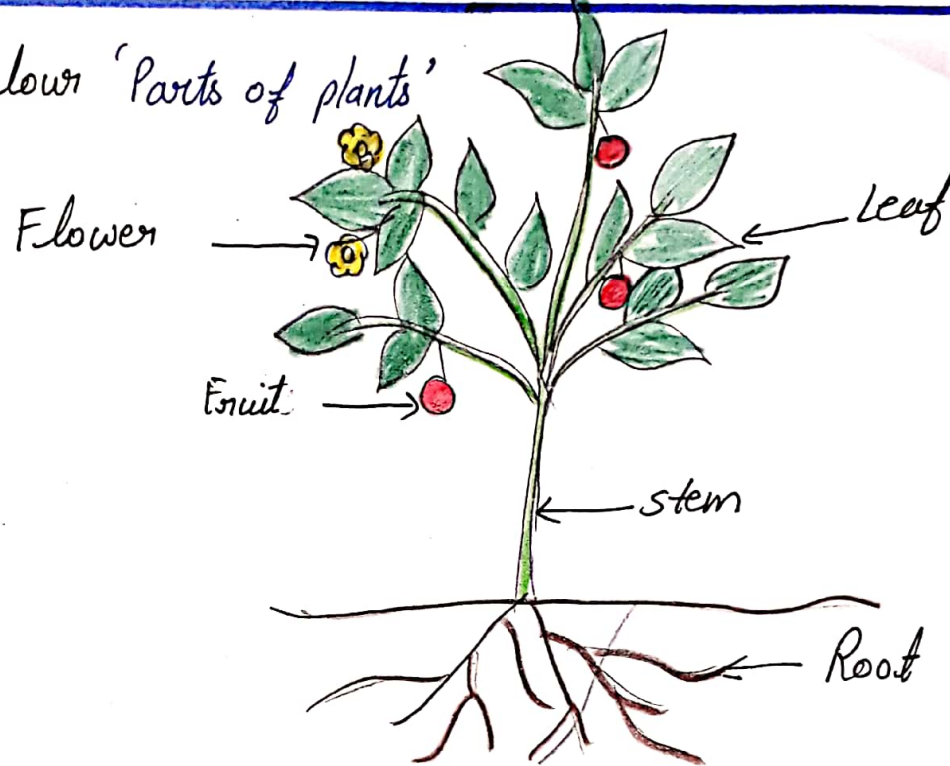
Fibrous root → Ex. → Wheat, Rice, maize etc.

★ Roots absorb water and salts from the soil.

Plants give us oxygen to breathe in.

### 'Parts of Leaf'

\* The leaf has many tiny pores called stomata

\* There is a thin tube in the middle of the leaf called the 'main veins'
