L-2 Parts of a Computer

- **Monitor** looks like a TV. It is also called a Visual Display Unit or VDU. A monitor displays the work done on the computer.
- The **CPU** is also called the brain of a computer. It controls the other parts of a computer.
- A **keyboard** has usually 104 keys on it. These keys are used to type letters, numbers and symbols.
- A **mouse** usually has two buttons and a scroll wheel on it. A mouse helps us point at and select different things on the monitor.
