Q1. What does a habitat provide to the animals which live in it?

A1. A habitat provides all the basic needs such as air, water, food and shelter to the animal.

Q2. Name some animals that breathe through the gills.

A2. Fish, Prawns, crabs and tadpoles breathe with the help of gills.

Q3. How do frogs and butterflies eat their food?

A3. Frogs use their long, sticky tongue to catch insects and small worms. Butterflies suck the nectar from flowers through Proboscis.

Q4. Why are feathers important to birds?

A4. Feathers help in flying, they protect birds from heat, rain and cold.

Q5. Describe the movement in fishes.

A5. Fishes swim with the help of their fins. The paired fins help them to swim, the tail fin helps them to change direction, while the unpaired fins help them to maintain balance.
